## Health Care

Upon arrival to camp, campers will have a health screening by the healthcare manager. The screening is to look for any sickness that is communicable such as head lice and flu. Any concerns will be discussed with parents/guardians. If you think your camper has head lice or are in the process of treating head lice, please do not come to camp. If head lice are detected, she will be sent home. Once treated, she may come back to camp 24 hours from treatment. Upon arrival, she will be screened again to ensure the lice has been eliminated.

All medication must be turned in to the healthcare manager during check-in. Over the counter or prescribed medication must be in the <u>original container labeled with the camper's name</u>, medicine, prescribed dosage and time to be administered. All medication will be given in the prescribed dosage in the presence of an adult as per written instructions of a custodial parent, a guardian, or a physician. The camper may need to carry and administer some medications, such as bronchial inhalers. Herbal remedies are not viewed as prescribed dosages unless a doctor's note has accompanied the herbal remedies.
